APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Apply by: Completing the exemption Application Form
- Exemption Fee: RM200 per subject exempted
payable to "The Malaysian Insurance Institute"
- Processing Time: 2 weeks
- Only forms that are attached with supporting documents will be processed.
 - Exemption process will be longer if a particular qualification upon which exemption is sought is being assessed for the first time.

Exemptions can be awarded if the syllabus for an MII subject has been substantially covered by a specific external qualification offered by a particular awarding body. MII will determine whether a particular course is of a standard comparable with those applied to MII subject.

There is already a wide range of awarding bodies-other professional institutes, universities, colleges-both in Malaysia and overseas, for which exemption awards have been agreed.

The full list is too long, and subject to amendment and additions, to publish here. Indeed, given the number and variety of course which are available, it is not possible to establish, in advance, an exemption award for every qualification candidates may hold.

If you have qualification which you think might provide the basis for an exemption, you should complete the exemption form. You can apply for exemption at any stage in your studies. You should check the syllabus of the subject(s) for which you think you may gain exemption. Do this before ordering the course books as you cannot change the book if you subsequently apply for, and are granted, an exemption from the subject.

If exemptions have been established for your qualification, your eligibility will be checked and exemptions granted accordingly. If you are the first candidate to seek exemption for a particular qualification, you will be sent details of the information MII needs to decide on an exemption. You should send these details to your awarding body. You should note that, irrespective of how many exemptions your qualifications might provide, there is an overriding rule that you must complete at least one subject in the MII exams from the post range of AMII subjects.

Every new exemption award is carefully considered, so there may be a delay while information is being collated by the external body and appraised by MII. You can still start studying for your chosen MII qualification but you should avoid entering a subject for which you consider exemption to be a possibility. If you fail in any MII examination subject and subsequently gain an external qualification which would make you eligible for exemption from that subject, you are allowed to claim the exemption.



Exemptions can be awarded by the Examination Committee if it is satisfied that the syllabus for MII / CII subject has been substantially covered (80% similarity) by a specific external qualification offered by a particular awarding body and has been assessed using a technique and at a standard comparable with those applied to MII subject.

Kindly take note that we only process exemption application of those who are registered as students with MII.

Exemption should be applied for together with the submission of the exemption form. Each application must be accompanied by the following documents:

- A certified copy of detailed results;
- A certified copy of syllabus for a particular subject(s) and
- A written confirmation from the Academic Registrar or any other person of equal standing in the institution concerned that the syllabus is substantially identical to that of the subject(s) for which exemption is applied for.

Applicants have to pay a processing fee at the time of application and an exemption fee upon confirmation of the exemption.

Exemptions are not granted:

- If a student has previously sat and failed the subject in the MII or CII examination, even if the student has subsequently gained a qualification which would otherwise be regarded as equivalent.
- If the student's application is based on a partially completed qualification even if they have passed a subject which would be regarded as equivalent and
- For qualifications not gained by examination.

Only the following forms of certification will be accepted. Photocopies of original certificates, provided that such copies bear a certification by either:

- 2 Associates or Fellows of MII or CII;
- 2 officers of MII any 2 of : the general manager of a principal insurance company, the branch manager of the principal insurance company,
- a member of MII branch committee or
- a Commissioner for Oaths

Professional Examination Qualifications Conducted by Recognised Insurance Institution.

Exemptions will be granted from subjects of the Diploma examination from professional examination qualifications conducted by the following insurance institutions when examinations in appropriate options have been passed:

- The American Institute for Property and Liability Underwriters.
- Australian and New Zealand Institute of Insurance & Finance.
- The Insurance Institute of America.
- The Insurance Institute of Canada.



Other qualifications

You may be granted exemption from subjects of the Diploma examination on the basis of professional and academic qualifications which, in the opinion of the Examination Committee, are of an equivalent standard and scope.

It is not possible to provide a complete list of the qualifications for which Associateship exemptions have been agreed. The list below gives an indication of the type and level of qualification which can attain dispensations. For confirmation of your exemption status you should complete the exemption application form and submit the appropriate fees.

Degree in business studies, economics, commerce, business administration, etc. may also attract exemptions.

Law degrees awarded by a UK higher education establishment will be eligible for exemption from subject AG31 (Company and contract law and their application of insurance). Those who are from qualified in the UK as solicitors or barristers will also be eligible for exemption from subject AG31 (Company and contract law).

For confirmation of your exemption status you should complete the exemption form and submit the appropriate documents and fees.
