DMII / AMII QUALIFICATION FRAMEWORK
CHANGES IN THE CII QUALIFICATION FRAMEWORK**

Warmest greetings from MII.

Further to our earlier announcement and with reference to several enquiries received to the implementation of DMII/AMII qualification framework in line with the changes to the CII, UK new framework, MII is pleased to confirm on the following matters :

1. Compulsory subject for Diploma and Associateship for all students :

- Effective January 2011, subject 105 Insurance Law and subject 109 Insurance Business and Finance are the compulsory subjects for Diploma and Associateship.
- Students who have passed by examination either subject 72 Modern Business Practice or subject 32 Business Environment would have satisfied the compulsory requirement for subject 109 Insurance Business and Finance.
- Students who were/are granted exemption for subject 72 Modern Business Practice and subject 32 Business Environment, will be/are required to sit for subject 109 Insurance Business and Finance. As exemption is awarded in accordance with the standards in place at the time of the application, it cannot be traded for any specific examination subject.

2. Enhanced / Advanced CII subjects

Please be informed that the following subjects are being offered by CII at the advanced/enhanced level. The assessment format will match the advanced/enhanced level. Therefore the examinations will consist of one case study and two (shorter) scenario questions.

The subjects are :

- 32 Business Environment
- 52 Risk Management
- 68 Marketing
- 100 Underwriting Management
- 101 Claims Management



However, after taking into consideration many factors and for the benefits of students, MII has decided that for the above mentioned subjects :

- Will not be offered at advanced / enhanced level and
- To maintain the current syllabus and
- To maintain the current assessment format

Therefore, we would encourage students to apply for accreditation of prior learning for the above mentioned subjects with CII before 31st December 2011 in order to receive 30 credits per subject at Advanced Diploma level.

Please take note that any applications received after 31 December 2011 will be awarded credits at Diploma level, as exemption is awarded in accordance with the standards in place at the time of the application, it cannot be traded for any specific examination subject.

3. Syllabus and course book

The examinations are based on the published syllabuses in the MII website, www.insurance.com.my. It is essential that the students to familiarize with the syllabus before commencing their study. For reference, please refer to the attached MII examination schedule for subjects offered and course books edition.
