MNRB SCHOLARSHIP FUND, a fund established by MNRB Holdings Berhad, a company listed on the Main Board of Bursa Malaysia and a subsidiary of Permodalan Nasional Berhad (PNB), in collaboration with **THE MALAYSIAN INSURANCE INSTITUTE (MII)**, invites suitably qualified staff of Insurance companies in Malaysia (including Brokers, Adjusters and Insurance Associations) to apply for **Scholarships** to pursue MII Professional Programmes in Insurance, namely:

- **DIPLOMA OF THE MALAYSIAN INSURANCE INSTITUTE (DMII)** or
- **ASSOCIATESHIP OF THE MALAYSIAN INSURANCE INSTITUTE (AMII)**

VALUE OF AWARD

The scholarships are valued at up to **RM3,250 for DMII** and up to **RM7,500 for AMII** for each successful candidate. It covers **50%** of the full programme fee which includes the following:

- Tuition Fee
- Exam Fee
- Exemption Fee

In addition to the above scholarships, student registration fee and one year MII membership for the total amount of RM105 per successful candidate will also be covered.

PROCEDURES OF SELECTION

- Minimum requirement
 - i) DMII programme - SPM / GCE 'O' Level
 - ii) AMII programme - STPM / Diploma or higher
- Applicants must be staff of insurance companies (including Brokers, Adjusters and Insurance Associations) with minimum 2 years of industry working experience
- Short listed candidates will be required to sit for a test and interview with MII on :
16 April 2012, Monday for DMII applicants, and
19 April 2012, Thursday for AMII applicants

MNRB Scholarship 2011 – F.A.Q

1. Is there any 'Bonding' if I take this scholarship?

No

2. How many years and what sort of working experience are required to be eligible?

Applicant must be staff of insurance companies with minimum 2 years of insurance industry working experience.

3. I have taken one subject of DMII. Am I allowed to apply for this scholarship?

Yes. However the scholarship is limited to 50% of the programme fee for the remaining subjects only.

4. What is covered under the scholarship?

The scholarships are valued up to RM3,250 for DMII and up to RM7,500 for AMII. It covers 50% of the full programme fee which includes:

- Tuition fee
- Exam fee
- Exemption fee

In addition, student registration fee and one year MII membership for the total amount of RM105 per candidate will also be covered.

5. Where is the venue of the classes?

The classes will be organized at MII either at Damansara Heights or Maju Junction Mall. The date and time will be advised to students later.

6. What is the timeframe of each qualification?

AMII – 3 years ; DMII – 2 years. This is inclusive of the remaining non sponsored subjects.

7. Will there be any penalty for withdrawal or not completing the programme?

Yes, penalty (equivalent to the amount spent during time of withdrawal) will be imposed on students on the following circumstances:

- *Withdrawal from the programme during the given time frame*
- *Failure to complete the programme within the given time frame (as no 6)*

8. How do I know if my application is successful?

The short listed candidates will be contacted to sit for a test and interview with the Scholarship Selection Committee at MII. The session is scheduled on 16 and 19 April 2012 for DMII and AMII respectively. Only after you succeed in that session, an offer letter will be given to you.

9. If the scholarship is only 50%, what are the other means of sourcing the remaining 50% ?

Successful candidates may seek sponsorship from their employer, withdraw from their EPF or self financing.

10. When is the commencement of the 2012 class for both DMII and AMII ?

We are planning to start the class in May 2012. Anyway, should there be any amendment to the commencement date, all students will be notified.

11. Do I need to pay back the scholarship to MNRB if I complete the programme successfully within the timeframe?

No.

12. Can I NOT attend the classes and sit for the final exams?

No. Class attendance is compulsory.

13. How often are the classes conducted?

On the average of two (2) evening classes per week over the period of 3 months (42 – 48 hours) per subject.

14. Can I NOT choose to join May Intake and pick and select from other intakes offered to complete the programme?

No. Students under this scholarship must strictly follow the class schedules organized for this intake.

15. Do you offer this scholarship and conduct classes for outstation students?

Scholarship is offered to all potential students including those outside Kuala Lumpur (KL), but most likely, classes will be conducted at MII since majority of students are from KL.

However, if ALL 15 successful candidates are outstation students of the same location, for example Penang, then we might consider to conduct the classes in Penang.

16. What are NOT covered under the Scholarship?

The following items will NOT be covered under MNRB Scholarship. They are:

- *Textbook (However student can refer to MII Resource Centre)*
- *Re-sitting / Repeat Fee*
- *Traveling or Expenses*
Other incidental cost incurred in attending the programmes.
